This past year has been transformative for HHM Health, marked by notable expansions, impactful partnerships, and new initiatives, all aimed at improving the care we provide to our community.

In the fall, we enhanced our OB/GYN services, allowing patients to receive comprehensive care, including deliveries and gynecological surgeries, directly from an HHM Health provider. We also opened an Optical Store in partnership with the Lighthouse for the Blind of Fort Worth at the Rosewood Vision Clinic, offering affordable eyewear for adults and children.

Our 304b pharmacy is thriving, providing patients with low-cost prescriptions, over-the-counter drugs, and more. This initiative is a testament to our commitment to making essential medications accessible to those in need.

We began 2024 on a high note by being selected as a 2024 Crystal Charity Ball beneficiary. This honor secures funding for a pediatric mobile clinic, set to launch in summer 2025, which will bring critical care to underserved children throughout Dallas County.

In February, we opened CeCe's Place, a maternal medical clinic in partnership with Hope Cottage, now serving patients every Monday and Wednesday. Additionally, our new HHM Health at South Dallas location opened in March, offering comprehensive healthcare services to the local community, including clients of nearby Viola's House.

We are addressing high infectious disease rates in our community, particularly in Vickery Meadow and South Dallas. To tackle this, we formed an Infectious Disease Prevention and Care Team, including an infectious disease physician, family

medicine, and behavioral health professionals. We are thrilled to report that we have cured our first patient with HIV, marking a significant milestone.

The Healing Hands Luncheon raised over \$338,000 to support individuals in need of healthcare. We extend our heartfelt thanks to everyone who contributed or attended. Your support makes a profound impact on the lives of those we serve.

We are excited to announce that we opened HHM Health at Mesquite in mid-June to continue providing essential healthcare services in the area after Mission East closed.






Helen's Story



"HHM HEALTH IS HELPFUL TO MY FAMILY AND COMMUNITY. NO MATTER WHERE YOU ARE FROM, LANGUAGE IS NOT A BARRIER. I HAVE BROUGHT SEVERAL OF MY FRIENDS HERE"

In 2014, Helen Cingpi bravely immigrated to the United States from Burma, driven by the desire for safety, freedom, education, and better opportunities. Settling in Dallas, she faced the daunting task of rebuilding her life in an unfamiliar land while attending school.

By 2017, Helen encountered a new challenge: finding healthcare that was affordable, high-quality, and accessible in her native language. Unsure where to turn, she found hope through a friend's recommendation and discovered HHM Health. She began visiting the Vickery Women's Clinic, where she received the routine care she needed. Reflecting on her experience, she shares.

"Being a patient at HHM Health makes me feel safe and loved. I am able to get good quality care and be part of a great community. The staff is trustworthy. I really trust the doctors here and I feel safe."

Helen's positive experience with HHM Health inspired her to give back. She started working as a translator and care navigator, helping others understand their healthcare options and overcome the fear of language barriers. "HHM Health is helpful to my family and community. No matter where you are from, language is not a barrier. I have brought several of my friends here. I love to tell people about HHM Health," she says proudly.

Helen's bond with HHM Health deepened as she welcomed her two children, Cinszan and Grace, with the support of their pediatric clinic. Her children continue to receive care from HHM Health today, reflecting the trust she places in their services.

As her focus shifted to caring for her children, Helen transitioned to volunteering at HHM Health. Recently, she assisted with the Burmese Refugee Cooking Classes, a role that allows her to give back to the community that supported her. Helen expresses her deep gratitude for HHM Health, emphasizing the profound difference that compassionate, quality, and inclusive healthcare can make in the lives of individuals and communities



Melissa's Story



Melissa Banks' journey with HHM Health began in 2011 when she discovered she was pregnant. Living in the Lake Highlands area, she sought prenatal care at Presbyterian Hospital and was referred to providers at what was then Healing Hands Ministries. Reflecting on those early visits, Melissa fondly recalls, "They were very detailed when they checked me. They truly wanted to help me and get to know me. It was not just in-and-out. They made me feel comfortable."

Over the years, Melissa's appreciation for HHM Health has only grown. The continuity in quality care and the familiar faces have left a lasting impression. "The care is the same. Many of the people are the same, and they know me. People like Ms. Pam have watched me grow up, and I have watched them grow up, too," she shares. This sense of community and familiarity has made HHM Health a true healthcare home for Melissa and her family.

Melissa has found more than just a clinic at HHM Health; she has found a place where she feels welcomed and cared for. She brought her children—Journi, Elli, Paige, and Liam—into the world here and continues to bring them for regular check-ups. "With every visit, the doctors watch my children hit their milestones, approaching my children with a smile, hello, and hugs, calling them by name.

Here, Melissa and her children have found not just healthcare, but a community that supports them every step of the way.



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

Healthcare Hero

Dr. Larry Gray's dedication to children's health spans an impressive six decades. After completing his undergraduate studies at Texas Christian University, Dr. Gray went on to earn his medical degree at the Ohio State University College of Medicine in 1967. He then honed his expertise through residencies in pediatrics at both West Virginia University Hospitals and Akron Children's Hospital GME. Board-certified by the American Board of Pediatrics, Dr. Gray's career path took an unexpected turn when he was drafted into the Air Force during the Vietnam War, serving in Japan. Upon returning to the US, he entered private practice before finding his true calling at HHM Health.

Dr. Gray's journey with HHM began at its very roots.

"We started at Healing Hands when it was just a
little clinic," he recalls. "I started as a volunteer for
the Dallas County Medical Society. We found that
the people here were so gracious and grateful."

Drawn to the Skillman location near his home, Dr.
Gray saw a critical need to provide care for the
underinsured population. His time volunteering
sparked a powerful desire to make a lasting impact.

"That's when the idea first came to mind," Dr. Gray
says, "of donating my practice and office to HHM
Health whenever my time for retirement comes."
